<u>Swimming</u>: The school pool is now in use. Please make sure that your child's togs and towels are named and in a plastic bag. The teachers will tell your children what days and times they will be swimming. From Week 3 Swimsation will be at the school giving swimming lessons to the children from Years 3-6.

<u>Teacher Only Day</u>: On Friday 07 February the school will be closed for learning while the whole school staff take part in a Professional Development day.
