Possible home learning structure

(Note - where possible it is advisable to limit time on devices to half-hour slots, with more than one child at home make sure that you set a clear timetable to avoid any arguments)

9 am -9.30 am	Play, fitness, active game	Eg family walk around block or garden, <u>Go noodle</u> fun exercise indoors fun for family, skipping rope or hula hoop fun, Just Dance kids, Yoga https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LhYtcadR9nw
9.30 am-11.00 am	Learning time	Organise this time so children rotate with different activities (see suggestions below) e.g 20 minutes Maths buddy, TKI NZ Maths activity, https://nzmaths.co.nz/families-and-wh-nau Study Ladder, then jigsaw puzzles, number games, such as snakes and ladders, hopscotch
11.00 am -11.30 am	Break & chore time	If possible spend time outside, eat a snack, kick a ball around, jump on a trampoline, creative and imaginative play Chore time -Tidy bedroom, tidy toys
11.30 am - 1 pm	Learning time	Organise this time so children rotate with different activities e.g 10 minute reading, then a hands on alphabet and or basic sight words game, such as word bingo, fun writing activities see suggestions below
1 pm - 2pm	Lunch	Children to be involved in preparing lunch - talk about the ingredients, equipment- at least half an hour free play-time.
2pm-3pm	Learning time	Science and Technology Social Sciences Art See suggestions below

Writing

- Keep a daily diary (maybe take a photo first to inspire your writing)
- Write a lunch/dinner menu
- Cut out a magazine/newspaper picture and write about it
- Write about something you see outside
- Draw a picture and write a sentence about your picture
- Use the words on your sticker charts in a sentence
- Build something to write about (castle, animal, jigsaw, etc)


