- Our school is **secure**. Although we were not put into official lockdown by the police after the shooting, there already is a **'safety net**' in place- our locked gates.
- Daily opportunities for senior leadership to *personally greet students*.
- Calm students entering classrooms.
- Uninterrupted focussed relationship- building before the morning bell.
- Students, especially our 'babies' are continuing to develop self management skills as they walk themselves to their classrooms.
- Parents can 'kiss and go'. No need to unload younger children from the car in order to walk up to the classroom.
